## PA. DISTRICT 27 INTERNATIONAL BASEBALL AND SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT GAME PROCEDURES FOR ALL DIVISIONS

Rules and Guidelines published by Little League Headquarters apply throughout the International tournaments. Rules and guidelines can be found in the back of the Little League Rule Books. Review them carefully and be governed accordingly. It is important to remember this tournament is the showcase of Little League Baseball and Softball. Good sportsmanship must be maintained by all at all times. The conduct of players and fans is the direct responsibility of the team Manager and League Officials.

1. Use of the tournament playing field for pre-game warm-up, etc. is at the discretion of the host League. It is suggested this be done prior to arriving at the game site.
2. The team traveling the least number of miles will occupy the Third (3<sup>rd</sup>) base dugout.
3. The team traveling the most number of miles will occupy the First (1<sup>st</sup>) base dugout.
4. All fields are neutral. A coin flip will determine home and visiting team. The team traveling the most number of miles will call the coin flip.
5. At least 30 minutes prior to the start of the game, each team will provide 3 copies of game line-up and six leather covered official Little League baseballs (2 softballs if softball game) to the Game Director. Balls may be returned to teams at the conclusion of the game.
6. At least 15 minutes prior to the start of the game, Managers, Coaches, Umpires, and Game Director will meet at home plate to discuss ground rules, coin toss, pre-game questions, etc.
7. Both teams will line up on the foul lines when introduced and remain there for the National Anthem and Little League Pledge.
8. Both teams will meet at the home plate area at the conclusion of the game and shake hands.
9. Teams must be sure they know the time, date, location, etc. of their next scheduled game before leaving the field. Managers must assure they have their affidavit properly completed and returned to them prior to leaving the game site.
10. After completion of your game please clean up the dugout/bench area and if a game is scheduled after yours please leave the dugout as quickly as possible so the next teams can enter and prepare for their game. There is no on-deck batter in the 9-10, 11, and Little League Divisions.
