2011 9 YEAR OLD ALL STAR INVITATIONAL SPECIAL GAMES

- 1. This Double Elimination Little League Special Games is under the jurisdiction of the District 27 Administrator and is intended for fun and friendship. Little League patches/emblem or the words LITTLE LEAGUE shall be worn and/or displayed on each player's uniform.**
- 2. Participation is by invitation only. Leagues in good standing with Little League and District 27 may be invited by the District 27 Administrator only.**
- 3. Managers, coaches and players must be regular season managers, coaches, and players and participated in at least 60 percent of the regular season games and must be in good standing with Little League Baseball and District 27.**
- 4. Teams must consist of players with League age of 9 years old. More than one team may be entered but cross players are not permitted. Maximum 14 per roster which must be presented to the District Administrator prior to the first game. USE OF INELIGIBLE PLAYER (S) COULD RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF GAMES AND SUSPENSION OF TEAM FROM FURTHER SPECIAL GAMES PLAY.**
- 5. Any Little League Baseball restriction(s) in effect regarding Participation in Other Programs for the 9-10 Year Old Baseball International tournament team are in effect for this tournament.**
- 6. Regular season LL substitution (Rule 3.03) and mandatory play rule (LL Reg. IV (i)) apply. Exception: Continuous batting, i.e. all players shall be in the batting order and bat.**
- 7. Pitchers may pitch a maximum of 3 innings per game and only every other played game. One pitch constitutes an inning pitched. Little League Tournament Pitch Count is in effect for this tournament.**
- 8. Each manager will maintain a pitching log throughout the tournament. Opposing managers are to share the pitching log prior to the start of the game and agree on which players have either limited or no eligibility to pitch during that game. At the end of the game, managers are to verify & initial the opposing manager's pitching log.**
- 9. Managers/Coaches in the Dugout – There is a maximum of three (3) adults permitted to act as manager/coaches/scorekeeper for the game. At least one (1) adult must be in the dugout at all times.**
- 10. Team traveling the least miles will occupy the third base dugout/bench. Team traveling the most miles will occupy the first base dugout/bench. All fields are neutral. A coin toss will determine home team. Team traveling the most miles will call the coin toss.**

11. **Stealing is not permitted. However, if a defensive play is made on a base runner, the ball is live and runners may advance at their own risk of being put out. A batter may not advance to second base as a result of a base on balls.**
12. **The infield fly rule does apply. No balks will be called in the 9 year old Special Games.**
13. **Six (6) runs in a 1/2 inning make automatic 3 outs. After the 5th inning, the six run rule does not apply, i.e. inning ends when 3 outs are made.**
14. **If at the end of a regulation game, one team has a lead of 10 runs or more, the team with the fewest runs shall concede the victory to the opponent. NOTE: If the visiting team has a lead of 10 or more runs, the home team must bat in their half of the inning.**
15. **Each team will provide 2 regulation Little League baseballs per game.**
16. **Umpires will be assigned by the Host Leagues. The District 27 Staff will either review umpire assignments or provide umpires for the semi-final and final games.**
17. **Post game refreshments may be provided at the discretion of the Host League.**
18. **Any rule not covered here will be ruled on by the District 27 Administrator whose decision is final.**
19. **NOTE: Any player, manager, and/or coach who is ejected from a game could also be suspended from further participation. TEAM MANAGERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR PLAYERS, COACHES, AND FANS.**
20. **THERE IS NO ON DECK BATTER IN LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL.**
