John would have all three fields going at once for most of the day. 2011 JOHN KLEIN MEMORIAL 11-12 YEAR OLD ALL STAR SPECIAL GAMES TOURNAMENT

- 1. This Double Elimination Little League Special Games is under the jurisdiction of the District 27 Administrator and is intended for fun and friendship. Participation is by invitation only. Leagues in good standing with Little League Baseball and District 27 may be invited by the District 27 Administrator only.**
- 2. Little League patches/emblems or the words LITTLE LEAGUE shall be displayed on each player's uniform.**
- 3. Managers, coaches, and players must have been regular season managers, coaches, and players and participated in at least 60 percent of the regular season, not named to any Little League International tournament team, and must be in good standing with Little League Baseball and District 27.**
- 4. Teams must consist of players League age 11 or 12. USE OF INELIGIBLE PLAYER (S) COULD RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF GAMES AND SUSPENSION OF TEAM FROM FURTHER SPECIAL GAMES PLAY. More than one team may be entered, but cross players are not permitted. Players League age 10 years old who participated in the Major League during the regular season may participate in this Special Games with the approval of the District 27 Administrator. Maximum 14 per roster which must be presented to the District Administrator prior to the 1st game.**
- 5. International Tournament Pitching Rules, Game Suspension Rules, Mandatory Play, and Tournament substitution rules published by Little League Baseball apply. Tournament rules and guidelines are located in the back of the regular season Little League Baseball Rule Book and amended on the Little League web site.**
- 6. Each manager will maintain a pitching log throughout the tournament. Opposing managers are to share the pitching log prior to the start of the game and agree on which players have either limited or no eligibility to pitch during that game. At the end of the game, managers are to verify & initial the opposing manager's pitching log.**
- 7. Managers/Coaches in the Dugout – A maximum of three (3) adults will be permitted to act as manager/coach/scorekeeper for a game. At least one (1) adult must be in the dugout at all times.**
- 8. Team traveling the least miles will occupy the third base dugout. Team traveling the most miles will occupy the first base dugout. All fields are neutral. A coin toss will determine home team. Team traveling the most miles will call the coin toss.**
- 9. Each team will provide 2 regulation Little League baseballs per game.**

10. Umpires will be assigned by the Host Leagues. The District 27 Staff will review umpire assignments for the semi-final and final games.
11. If at the end of a regulation game, one team has a lead of 10 runs or more, the team with the fewest runs shall concede the victory to the opponent. NOTE: If the visiting team has a lead of 10 or more runs, the home team must bat in their half of the inning.
12. Post game refreshments may be provided at the discretion of the Host League.
13. Any rule not covered here will be ruled on by the District 27 Administrator whose decision is final.
14. Any player, manager and/or coach ejected from a game may be suspended from further Special Games participation. **TEAM MANAGERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR PLAYERS, COACHES, AND FANS.**
15. **THERE IS NO ON DECK BATTER IN LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL.**
