2011 MAJOR LEAGUE BASEBALL MAJOR LEAGUE TEAM INVITATIONAL SPECIAL GAMES

1. **This Single Elimination Little League Special Games is under the jurisdiction of the District 27 Administrator and is intended for fun and friendship.**
2. **Little League patches/emblem or the words LITTLE LEAGUE shall be worn and/or displayed on each player's uniform.**
3. **Participation is by invitation only. Leagues in good standing with Little League Baseball and District 27 may be invited by the District 27 Administrator only.**
4. **Managers, coaches, and players must have been regular season managers, coaches and players with the entered team for at least 60 percent of the season and must be in good standing with Little League Baseball and District 27.**
5. **Teams must be regular season Major League Teams, (All Star combination and/or "pick-up" players not permitted). USE OF INELIGIBLE PLAYER (S) COULD RESULT IN FORFEITURE OF GAMES AND SUSPENSION OF TEAM FROM FURTHER SPECIAL GAMES PLAY. Maximum of two teams may be entered. Roster must be presented to the District Administrator prior to the 1st game. (Note: Roster can be faxed or e-mailed)**
6. **International Tournament Pitching Rules, Game Suspension Rules, and Tournament substitution rules published by Little League Baseball apply. International Tournament rules and guidelines are located in the back of the regular season Little League Baseball Rule Book.**
7. **Each manager will maintain a pitching log throughout the tournament. Opposing managers are to share the pitching log prior to the start of the game and agree on which players have either limited or no eligibility to pitch during that game.**
8. **Only Manager, two coaches OR Manager, one Coach and a scorekeeper, i.e. a TOTAL of three (3) adults, and players are permitted in the dugout/bench area. Team traveling the least miles will occupy the third base dugout/bench. Team traveling the most miles will occupy the first base dugout/bench. All fields are neutral. A coin toss will determine home team. Team traveling the most miles will call the coin toss.**
9. **Each team will provide 2 regulation Little League baseballs per game.**
10. **Umpires will be assigned by the Host Leagues. The District 27 Staff will review umpire assignments for the semi-final and final games.**

11. If at the end of a regulation game, one team has a lead of 10 runs or more, the team with the fewest runs shall concede the victory to the opponent. NOTE: If the visiting team has a lead of 10 or more runs, the home team must bat in their half of the inning.
12. Post game refreshments may be provided at the discretion of the Host League.
13. Any rule not covered here will be ruled on by the District 27 Administrator whose decision is final.
14. Any player, manager and/or coach who is ejected from a game may be suspended from further Special Games participation. **TEAM MANAGERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR PLAYERS, COACHES, AND FANS.**
15. **THERE IS NO ON DECK BATTER IN LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL.**
